**Purpose:**            Updating of the Project Partnership Kit is designed to help continue the tradition of collaboration in water resources project development and management. The kit will help potential non-Federal sponsors to understand how USACE can help them with their water resources and related land problems. The updated kit will allow potential sponsors to better understand: 1) USACE organization and authorities; 2) the scope of USACE civil works missions and programs; 3) the project development process by which projects are planned, designed, constructed and maintained; and 4) the Project Delivery Team (PDT), of which the sponsor is an integral member.

**Objective:**        This project will use the last issue of the Project Partnership (2001) as a starting point. New authorities, programs, policies, guidance and changes to existing programs will be reviewed, summarized and incorporated into the new version of the Project Partnership Kit.
