




PROJECT OVERVIEW OF SCOPE



Authorized to construct a 110' x 600' navigation lock to replace the existing lock that suffers from structural instability due to Alkali Aggregate Reaction.








Lock Chamber Construction Contract:

03 Mar 2022 - Looking Upstream




03 Mar 2022 – Looking Downstream

The Lock Chamber contract is significantly behind schedule; a contractor submitted certified claim is under review with a response planned by 28 June 2022.

The previously reported new lock operational date of April 2024 will not be achieved; a new estimated on-line date will be determined following approval of the Lock Chamber contractor's schedule.

The June 2020 certified Total Project Cost and Schedule update estimated project completion between November 2025 – August 2027; this estimate will be revised in Fall 2022 once the Lock Chamber contract end date solidifies.

PROJECT ISSUES AND CHALLENGES



- The Lock Chamber contractor is significantly behind and efforts to regain schedule to achieve the current required contract completion date of 27 SEP 2023 have not been successful to date. The previously reported new lock operational date of APR 24 will not be achieved; a new on-line date will be estimated after confirming schedules for the Lock Chamber contract and followon work.
- The Lock Chamber Certified Claim alleges cost and schedule impacts due to a variety of items, most notably COVID-19. The claim is currently under review with a response planned by 28 June 2022.
