



#### ACOE ROLES - PRE-STORM

(96 Hours before landfall)

- Identify Safe Harbor Locations for Contractors' Dredges
- Alert and Strategically Locate Team Members if necessary
- Prepare Survey Vessels for Deployment
- Assess Resources for Surveying
- Conduct Pre-storm Meeting
- Implement Teleconferencing



### ACOE ROLES - STORM

- □Support Emergency Operations Center (EOC)
- ■Prepare for Damage Assessments
- Implement Teleconference Protocol
- Implement Coordination Protocol



### ACOE ROLES- POST-STORM

- Implement Teleconferences
- Assess Conditions-Priority for Re-openings
- Identify Projects Not Affected by Storm
- Implement Coordination Protocol
