

EXTENSION OF
THE IMPLEMENTING ARRANGEMENT
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS
AND
THE MINISTRY OF LAND, INFRASTRUCTURE, TRANSPORT AND TOURISM OF JAPAN
CONCERNING COOPERATION IN THE FIELDS OF FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER
RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

The United States Army Corps of Engineers and the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of Japan, with a view to promote cooperation between the two countries concerning cooperation in the field of flood control and water resources management and in accordance with the provision of Article 14 of the Implementing Arrangement between the United States Army Corps of Engineers and the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport of Japan Concerning Cooperation in the Field of Flood Control and Water Resources Management (hereinafter referred to as "the Implementing Arrangement"), which entered into force on March 18, 2003 and was concluded pursuant to paragraph 3 of Article II of the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Japan on Cooperation in Research and Development in Science and Technology, which entered into force on June 20, 1988, as extended and amended,

Have agreed as follows:

1. The Implementing Arrangement will be extended for 5 years, effective March 18, 2008.
2. This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties.
