

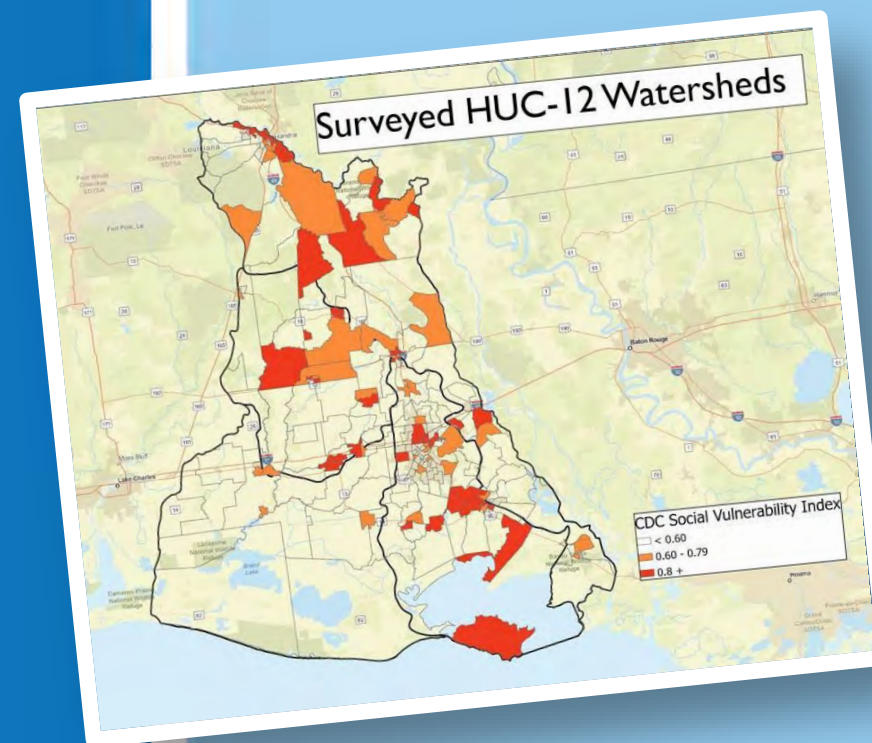


LOUISIANA WATERSHED INITIATIVE REGION 5 FLOOD VULNERABILITY ANALYSIS

A Flood-Vulnerability Indicator was developed to understand where the intersection of flood and social vulnerability within the identified areas is greatest

PRIMARY OUTCOME & CHALLENGES

- The purpose of this Louisiana Silver Jackets effort was to identify areas where future investment can be prioritized to best meet the needs of the communities that share both strong flood vulnerability and social vulnerability
- Communities that headline this list of combined vulnerability include Mamou, Unincorporated Iberia Parish, Delcambre, Erath, as well as Unincorporated Vermilion Parish
- These communities are expected to have considerable flood depths during the 1% AEP event while also experiencing significant factors for social vulnerability and may be considered by the APC as high priorities for future investment

- Open communication
