The project provided free educational and networking opportunities, designed for professionals in floodplain management, water management, emergency management, and related fields

**Webinars were presented** on how to support economically disadvantaged communities in flood risk management, managing risk to unsheltered populations in the floodway, how to raise flood risk awareness, engineering with nature, funding assistance for rural communities, National Flood Insurance Program updates, mitigation strategies, and the Community Rating System.
